Background:

As part of the Conditions of Approval for the Jacob's Park (Mosier Skatepark) CUP and the LUBA settlement agreement the skatepark rules will be approved through a public hearing process. The Skatepark Committee included members of the community, Main Street Mosier, and City Council members. This committee met on several occasions to develop the rules for the skatepark; these have been noticed and available to the public for review per the settlement agreement and public meeting law.

**Mosier Skatepark Working Group
Recommended Skatepark Policies & Rules
January 2026**

The following proposed policies and rules were developed and unanimously agreed upon by the Mosier Skatepark Working Group for consideration by the Mosier City Council.

Proposed Policies:

- Skatepark rules are posted onsite.
- Trash and recycling cans are provided onsite and maintained by the City.
- Concerns of activity at the skatepark can be reported to City Hall at 541-478-3505.
- Use of the skatepark is at the risk of the user.
- A City provided broom is kept onsite for skatepark users to clear debris.
- The Skatepark Committee, convened by Mainstreet Mosier, will meet no less than once a year, and more as needed, to review any complaints or issues and to consider additional policy recommendations (for example video surveillance, fencing, etc.).

Proposed Rules:

- Park hours are dawn to dusk; no overnight camping.
- No alcohol, smoking, vaping, or drugs of any kind.
- No fires or open flames.
- No motorized vehicles.
- No amplified music.
- No glass.
- Use the trash and recycling receptacles.
- Pick up after your pets.
- Use the public restrooms.
- Helmets and pads are highly recommended.
- Use of the skatepark is at the risk of the user.

The Skatepark Working Group also recommends that the City Council consider:

- Having a portable toilet onsite at the Skatepark.
- Video surveillance.
- Fencing along the Mosier Creek border to prevent falls.
- Installing signage near the "green chair area" area to protect the area and to deter people from using the space.
